Pennsylvania Residency Classification

Based on a student's domicile, Temple University has two tuition schedules. One is relevant for Pennsylvania residents, and the other for out-of-state residents and international students. For tuition purposes, Pennsylvania residency is determined in accordance with the criteria outlined in the "Pennsylvania Residency Guidelines (<http://www.temple.edu/registrar/documents/downloads/PennsylvaniaResidencyGuidelinesandApplication.pdf>)."
