Students come to Temple from all over the world. In fact, we have students from more than 100 countries. You're considered an international student if you hold, or will need to obtain, a non-immigrant visa, including a student visa (F-1), or an exchange visitor visa (J-1).

The best way to apply is by using Temple's online application (<https://admissions.temple.edu/apply/international-applicant>). If you prefer, you may also submit the Common Application (<https://www.commonapp.org>).

If you require a student visa, please log-in to the TUportal (<https://tuportal.temple.edu>) to submit the I-20 application, financial documents, and passport photo page online so that we can process an I-20 for you as quickly as possible.
