 - Open to business and non-business students.
 - Two of the three prerequisite courses and three of the four minor courses must be taken at Temple.
 - Minimum grade of C- is required in the prerequisite courses.
 - Minimum grade of C is required in the RMI courses.
 - A grade point average of 2.0 is required in the minor courses.
 - · Minor courses cannot be used to meet the minor requirements if already used to meet requirements for a major or different minor or certificate.
 - Courses for the minor must be completed prior to graduation; if completed, the minor will be recorded on the final transcript upon graduation.

Interested students should discuss with their school/college advisor on how the courses in the minor will fit into their overall degree plan and are strongly encouraged to declare the minor early in their academic career.
