Online Learning

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Temple University's online learning experiences are designed to give students a rigorous, high-quality education that provides more flexibility in when and how they attend classes. Courses are offered at both the undergraduate and graduate levels as well as for continuing education students.

Continuing degree-seeking (matriculated) students can register online via Self-Service Banner in the TUportal. Non-degree seeking students must register through the Office of Continuing Studies in the Academic Resource Center at Mitten Hall, Suite 110 (215-204-2500). How online learning works: Each week, a student will access Canvas to view assignments and reading materials and participate in collaborative discussions or projects with instructors and classmates. Some online programs and courses require students to meet virtually using live web conference video technologies. Students should understand that online learning experiences are rigorous and require the same level of preparation and effort as traditional courses.
